Birmingham Leonardo Royal Access Audit

The front entrance of the Hotel has a ramp to the front door.

There is a raised area with seating, near the front door which is only accessed by stairs. However the hotel reception itself has a step free approach.



The Hotel bar, restaurant and coffee shop are all on the ground floor with a flat (no steps) entrance.

The Function Rooms are all on the first floor, accessed via four large lifts. This gives plenty of space for mobility scooters.

The function rooms are carpeted with a short pile carpet.

All of the bedrooms are accessible from the lift (no steps) and the hotel says they have accessible rooms, but these do not have walk in showers.

The car park at the rear of the building and can be accessed by the lifts. The main parking has a height barrier of 1.7m. They have some parking bays without height restrictions, including some blue badge parking. The multi-storey car park is accessed by stairs.

The restaurant serves food that is Gluten free, Vegetarian and Vegan as standard, but say they can cater to other allergies and dietary requirements on request.
